Dear Parents

We are very happy that you intend to come to this year's Celebrate Life Festival. We as the team of Transparents (www.transparents.net) have also taken over the entire children and youth accompaniment this year and think that being a parent fits perfectly to the festival theme "home". It is very important to us that we implement some mystical principles in our contact with the children, such as the bond, the incarnation of a soul and thus the potential development of a child and respect for the inner rhythm of life.

We kindly ask you to make sure that you give your children enough time to arrive safely with their companions and only leave when your children have really landed. You are always welcome to simply be there with your children in the morning or afternoon or to visit your children in between and to join your child in an attitude of quiet presence and simply be with him.

And most importantly, please always pick up your children on time, even if the tent is covered. It's just not nice for the children to have to wait while others are being picked up. In the following we have a few organizational questions, which we ask you to answer and bring to the respective care tent on the first day.

I am aware that my child can be excluded from the further festival stay in case of considerable repeated misconduct or for health reasons after consultation and in the event that he or she is there without parents, he or she can be collected from the festival at his or her own expense. If I cannot pick up my child myself, I agree that he/she may be sent home at my expense.

10. Liability:

PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN

The children's tent, JUKI-, TEENS- and BOOMERANG- Camp are not liable for your children/young people.

We assume no responsibility for the behaviour and actions of the participants in the children's tent, JUKI, TEENS and BOOMERANG camp.

The participation of the children/young people in the festival is at their own risk.

11. The children and teenagers do not have a compulsory stay in their camp or have no obligation to participate in the group times. That means - they can move freely on the festival area - on which there is also a lake. It is not our responsibility to enter the lake. If a child/young person does not appear at group time, there is no obligation to supervise; if a child/young person leaves the group during the official group times, the obligation to supervise expires until this is possible again. Outside group times, the child's/youth's stay on the entire premises is at his/her own risk. Liability claims against TransParents or the Celebrate-Life-Festival staff for breach of duty of supervision are limited to cases of intent and gross negligence.

We reserve the right to exclude children/young people without a letter from their parents from the respective programme.
